

LOTUS Buildings in Operation V1

Summary of changes from Pilot Version

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1. Introduction

LOTUS BIO V1 is the latest version of LOTUS Buildings in Operation (LOTUS BIO) superseding LOTUS BIO Pilot Version which was released in July 2013.

This document aims to highlight all the changes that have been brought from LOTUS BIO Pilot to LOTUS BIO V1.

In general, LOTUS BIO V1 has been developed with the idea to better reward the improvements made by projects and the good operational management practices.

The main changes brought in LOTUS BIO V1 include:

- the introduction of the Platinum Certification level (in line with all the other LOTUS rating systems)
- the introduction of a Certification renewal stage for projects to maintain their LOTUS
 Certification every 5 years
- the introduction of a new category named Sustainable Purchasing including 2 credits: Low-carbon purchasing and Healthy purchasing.
- the removal of the H-PR-3 Hazardous Substances prerequisite and the addition of a new prerequisite: Facility Audit
- the addition of 2 new credits: Green Cleaning and Public Awareness Campaign
- the removal of few credits: W-2 Water Use Intensity, H-3 Hazardous Substances, CY-1 Public Space and CY-2 Local Jobs.
- the introduction of new strategies in some credits to offer more compliant paths to projects
- the readjustment of some credit requirements (a number of requirements in LOTUS BIO Pilot were equivalent or very close to the requirements in LOTUS NR whereas it is a lot more challenging for an existing building to be compliant)
- the correction of a few mistakes

2. General changes

The table below highlights the general changes from LOTUS BIO Pilot to LOTUS BIO V1.

Section	Description of the changes
LOTUS Eligibility	 Eligibility rule 2 - Multi-tenant Buildings is now removed. Details on how multi-tenant buildings should apply LOTUS BIO are provided in section LOTUS BIO for Multi-tenant Buildings. Eligibility rule 4 - Building Age has been modified. To be eligible, a building must have already been fully operational for a minimum of 2 years at the time of Certification and not at the time of Registration.
LOTUS BIO Categories	 A new Category: Sustainable Purchasing, has been introduced to encourage the use of greener, healthier, and more sustainable products.
LOTUS BIO Prerequisites	 The number of prerequisites has been reduced to 8.
LOTUS BIO Credits	 Some LOTUS credits now have requirements encompassing different options or different strategies: A project can only select one of the proposed options to comply with a credit but it can implement any of the proposed strategies and cumulate points for the credit (while being restricted by the maximum number of points available for the credit).
LOTUS Certification Levels	 LOTUS BIO V1, in line with the other LOTUS rating systems, introduces a new certification level to recognize more effectively the higher performance reached by some projects. Following the LOTUS Certified, Silver and Gold levels, a LOTUS Platinum certificate is available for LOTUS projects.
LOTUS BIO for Multi-tenant Buildings	 Specific information for multi-tenant buildings is provided in this section. For credits and prerequisites involving tenants, the project should involve a minimum of 90% of the occupied GFA in order to be considered compliant
LOTUS BIO Certification Process	 At the end of the validity of the LOTUS BIO Full Certification, projects can maintain their certifications by following a Certification Renewal stage.
Performance Period	 2 different Performance Periods are now defined: the Initial Performance Period used to assess the performance of the building at the Full Certification stage the Renewal Performance Period used to assess the performance of the building at the Certification Renewal stage
LOTUS Provisional Certification	 The LOTUS Provisional Certification stage is optional and no more certification levels will be awarded at this stage.
LOTUS Submissions	 4 types of submissions are now described: Provisional Certification Submissions Full Certification Submissions Operational stage Submissions Certification Renewal Submissions

E-PR-1 Energy Audit	E-PR-1 Energy Audit	■ The energy auditor conducting the audit should be qualified with either a certificate of energy auditor or at least 2 years of experience in energy auditing.
E-1 Energy Audit (1 point)	E-1 Energy Audit (2 points)	■ An additional step has been included. Projects performing a detailed investment-grade energy audit of the building can now earn 2 points in the credit.
E-2 Energy Use Intensity (15 points)	E-2 Energy Use Intensity (15 points)	 The credit is split in 2 strategies: Strategy A: Benchmarking and Strategy B: Self-improvement. In Strategy A, the increment between points has been reduced from 2.5% to 1.5% of energy use intensity reduction compared to the benchmark. In Strategy A, an alternative method to set benchmark energy use intensity is added: peer group of comparable buildings In Strategy B, points will be allocated depending on how the building energy use intensity compares to the benchmark set in Strategy A. In BIO Pilot, points were awarded every 5% of energy use intensity reduction. In BIO V1, the percentage of energy use intensity reduction required to earn a point ranges from 1% to 3%.
E-3 Natural Ventilation (2 points)	E-3 Natural Ventilation and Air-conditioning	 New credit result of the merging of previous Natural Ventilation and HVAC credits. 4 strategies are included: Strategy A: Natural Ventilation and Strategy B: COP of air-conditioning system, Strategy C: Variable controls and Strategy D: Optimization of HVAC systems
E-4 HVAC (4 points)	(5 points)	 Strategy D aims to reward the efforts to optimize the efficiency existing systems through proper operations and maintenance.

E-5 Artificial Lighting (2 points)	E-4 Artificial Lighting (4 points)	 Credit now offers 4 points through 3 strategies: Strategy A: Reduction of Light Power Density, Strategy B: Space lighting controls and Strategy C: Daylighting lighting controls In Strategy A, maximum LPD values have been updated in line with QCVN 09:2013/BXD and now use building type instead of space type. Also, in Strategy A, one additional threshold for LPD reduction have been added and the method to calculate LPD has been modified to include the influence of ballasts.
